One of my pups, Stella, lives in Idaho with a potbellied pig, Hamlet. She loves



riding in the car. She has the run of the forest with acres to chase the deer, moose and pig for playmates. Rescued from the dumps, my pups have wonderful homes too!

Is it just me, or did summer come and go by too fast? I recently noticed a nip in the air and orange leaves beginning to fall to the ground. I guess the past few months have gone by so fast because we have been extremely busy at Auburn Valley Humane Society. Barkfest, one of our big events was a huge success and the Pets in Crisis and the Public Medical Fund programs have both had successful launches. Thrift Store sales increased, our animal intake almost doubled and most importantly, our live release rate of animals in our care has maintained at 97.3%. Our length of stay for cats is 9-12 days and for dogs is 7-8 days. Pretty remarkable to think about when just a few years ago our length of stay was averaging 20-40 days. At the half way point of 2018, AVHS is on track to meet and exceed all the budgetary expectations set by the Board of Directors for this year.

While this all may seem like business as usual at AVHS, it could not have happened without the efforts of our dedicated staff, the guidance and direction of our Board of Directors and the triumphs of this summer could not have happened without our loyal and hardworking volunteers. We have a great team here at the Auburn Valley Humane Society and as I look to the end of this year, I am very proud to be a part of this progressive animal welfare agency.

Auburn Valley Humane Society is now managing the Pet Licensing Program for the City of Auburn. By law all dogs and cats are required to be licensed in the City. The fine for not licensing your pet is \$50. Lost pets that come into the shelter with a license tag fastened to their collar are quickly identified and reunited with their owners. Give yourself some peace of mind by licensing your pet. AVHS has a goal to increase pet licensing by 18% this year. Help reunite more pets by promoting responsible pet ownership! All funds received from pet licensing directly benefit animals in the care of AVHS and the City of Auburn.
